### How to handle money...

We no longer offer a "Camp Bank". One week only campers will not need money. We do however give campers the opportunity to visit gift shops overseeing that they spend no more than \$15/\$20. Bringing no more \$20 is suggested for a one week camper. Two and three week campers will need about \$30 for each Disney and Catalina day as **lunch and dinner are not included**. ATM / cash machines are available at all outings and on the Azusa Pacific Campus.
